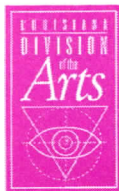

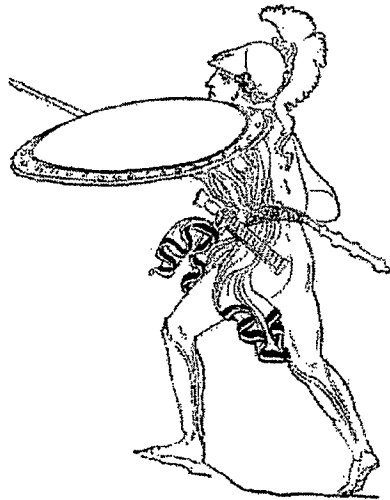

Missoula Children's Theatre comes to St. John Theatre

Auditions will be held for the Missoula Children's Theatre (MCT) production of Red Riding Hood at St. John Theatre on July 29th. Those auditioning should plan to stay for a full two hours. Some cast members will be asked to stay for a rehearsal immediately following the auditions.

The Missoula Children's Theatre touring production comes complete with costumes, scenery, props, and makeup. The MCT Actors/Directors will conduct rehearsals throughout the week.

Among the roles to be cast are Red Riding Hood, her three Girl-friends, Little Loveable Wolf, the Hood family, the Three Little Pigs, a Woodsman, a Locksmith, the Wolfgang, Forest Shadows, and some rascally raccoons. Students in Kindergarten through 12th grades are encouraged to audition. No advance preparation is necessary. Assistant Directors will be cast to aid in rehearsals throughout the week and to take on essential backstage responsibilities. Cost of the week will be \$75 per student.

Red Riding Hood will be presented on Saturday, August 3rd at St. John Theatre. The Missoula Children's Theatre residency in Reserve is presented locally by St. John Theatre & ACTS with support from River Region Arts & Humanities Council.
